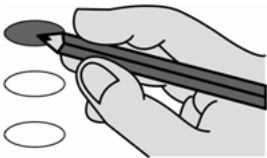

The use of the one percent (1%) local option sales and services tax shall be changed in the City of Bronson effective July 1, 2026. PROPOSED USES OF THE TAX: If the change is approved, revenues from the sales and services tax shall be allocated as follows: 0% for property tax relief. The specific purposes for which the revenues shall otherwise be expended are: 100% for any lawful purpose.
